

MSDS Data Probe Questions

The probe questions below are provided for district staff to use in their review of data or when developing a corrective action plan.

Common Indicator Probe Questions

- 1. How do district data compare to the state target?
- 2. Does the performance level reflect a systemic problem (i.e., involves multiple classrooms, buildings, providers, personnel changes, or processes), or is it attributable to specific buildings, providers, or groups of students?

Indicator-Specific Probe Questions

- 1. Are local data collection systems in place?
- 2. Is the data being entered correctly in the local student data system?
- 3. Are data submissions in the local student data system reviewed by more than one person?
- 4. Are the local student data system and the Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) interfacing without problems?
- 5. Are data submissions in the MSDS reviewed by more than one person before being certified?
