Member districts selected for a monitoring activity related to indicator B-9 (Disproportionate Representation – Child with a Disability) or B-10 (Disproportionate Representation – Eligibility Category) will receive a notification letter of the activity. Any intermediate school district (ISD) with one or more member districts participating in a monitoring activity will receive a copy of the notification letters on the Reports Page in Catamaran.
