

## Tier 3 Guidance

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## Michigan Department of Education Office of Special Education November 2024

A separate activity will be released on February 3, 2025 for ISDs with member districts in Tier 3.

Activities will be assigned based on three different levels.

- 1. Districts without flagged student files and no disproportionality will complete level one activities.
- 2. Districts with student files and no disproportionality will complete level two activities.
- 3. Districts with student files and disproportionality will complete level three activities.

For those ISDs with member districts who must complete file reviews:

- Initial reviews using the IEP team-facing rubric, of up to eight students in each of up to four member districts will be due April 14, 2025.
- Final file reviews and Educational Benefit Review summaries will be due June 30, 2025.

Districts in Tier 3 Level 3 with <u>disproportionality</u> must also use the rubric to review up to eight student cases from the over-identified subgroup of students (for example, Hispanic students), to ensure that each student meets all four required criteria to be eligible for alternate standards for assessments.
